It's somewhat more difficult to **change a business process**.



Competitiveness = IQ * Engagement




Personal commitment (belief)

RED HAT TAKES OVER OPENJDK STEWARDSHIP



- On April 17, 20 19, Red Hat announced that it was assuming the stewardship of the OpenJDK 8 and OpenJDK 11 projects following a transition of leadership from Oracle
- With the transition, Red Hat is affirming its support of the Java community and following a similar path that led to its leadership of both the OpenJDK 7 projects
- Red Hat also worked with the community to enable continued innovation in J ava, e.g. Shenandoah garbage collector included in OpenJ DK 12
